Literacy

This half term we will read, plan and write non-chronological reports. We will be reading the novel 'Kensuke's Kingdom' by Michael Morpurgo and use this as a stimulus for writing. We will continue to follow the National Curriculum in preparation for the Spelling, Grammar and Punctuation tests. Please help by supporting your child to learn their weekly spellings.

Science

This half-term we will be looking at the digestive and circulatory systems of the human body and learning about the importance of diet, exercise and lifestyle.

French

We will start a new topic naming and describing clothes.

Drama

This half term the children will begin rehearsing for our productions of 'Ali Baba and the Bongo Bandits'. They are working on performance skills and have already begun to embody their individual characters after only one read through! It's going to be a good one... We look forward to inviting you to the performances during the week commencing 3rd April

Music

The children will be preparing the songs for 'Ali Baba and the Bongo Bandits'

Numeracy

We will continue to follow the structure of the National Curriculum and will focus on data handling, algebra, calculating and problem solving with negative numbers and converting between different units of measure. Please continue to support your child in the learning of their times tables.

Topic

In history, we will be investigating significant conflicts across a wide range of historical periods and regions.

RE

Year 6 will be researching a special person of faith, whose life and actions have been inspired by religious beliefs and are an inspiration to others.

Art

We will be looking at the portrayal of war in art.
