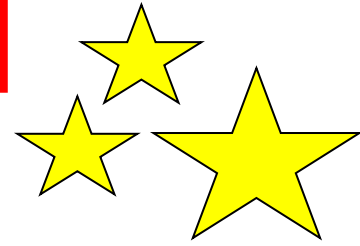




# YEAR 6



## Literacy

We will continue to follow the National Curriculum in preparation for the Spelling, Grammar and Punctuation tests. ## Numeracy

We will begin to research different forms of renewable energy and why these are important to the UK in the current climate. We will be visiting Scout Moor Wind Farm after Easter (dates are still to be confirmed) and creating wind turbines during Design and Technology.
